

Fig. 28. The shells of three species of microscopic, floating marine animals of the Genus <u>Globigerinoides</u>. Numbers 4 and 5 are shown at 260 diameters magnification with only a part of the shell in view. Numbers 6, 7, and 8 are entire shells shown at 100, 70, and 150 diameters respectively. Note that all have many minute pores for water circulation. All are from the western Pacific ocean, from sediment cores taken out of the ocean floor. Numbers 4 and 6 are from approximately 150 feet beneath the ocean floor, and number 8 is from approximately 220 feet. E. L.
